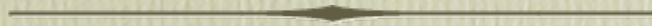

What's happened since RIPE48

- We have a logo!
- Basic web site now alive
- Successful outreach at CENTR GA and IETF60
- Advisory panel established
- First work items under way

CENTR GA

- Explained DNS-MODA's aims & rationale
- Discussion of funding model & governance issues
- Good feedback and supportive responses
 - Memberships yet to materialise but expected soon

IETF60

- Introductory meeting at San Diego
- Amazing response
 - Standing-room only
 - Expected ~20 attendees, got 70+
- Strong feedback on proposed fee structure
- Some concern about fragmenting IETF standards
 - Misunderstandings cleared up

Revised Fee Structure

- \$1000
- \$5000
- \$10000 - Minimum Entry point for for-profits
- \$25000 - Guaranteed place on Architecture Board
- \$50000 - Guaranteed place on Architecture Board

Membership News

- No-one signed up yet
 - Delays caused by summer holidays
- Several potential members close to joining
 - Computer vendors, TLD registries, telcos, telco manufacturers
 - Due diligence procedures under way

Work Items

- Project work funded by WIDE
 - Conformance testing
 - Lecture material for School of the Internet
- Results due by end 2004
 - Will demonstrate that DNS-MODA produces concrete results
