- Arab States

 - Working closely with AFRINIC
- Council Working Group participation

Concerns

- Broad language and concepts, unknown impact on Internet growth, openness and innovation
 - Who do the ITRs apply to?
 - WTSA, WTPF
 - (Recognised?) Operating Agencies (definition)
 - How will this be implemented?
 - Fundamental changes to operational practices of the Internet, and the associated costs (financial, technical, societal)

Concerns

- Fallout from the ETNO proposal is a concern for many operators (RIPE NCC members)
- Procedural concerns
 - Will the voices of those who operate the Internet be listened to?

- Engaging national governments
 - Some representatives joining national delegations, others attending in an independent capacity (Sector Members)
 - Participating in regional preparatory events
 - Producing documents and input for event delegates
