





1. Make the Internet worse by being badly run

Claim

- Personal ASNs are only run by people who do not know what they are doing
- They blow up the GRT and leak routes
- Low MTUs

- There is good & bad in personal ASN operations
- I still need to meet a pASN deaggregating their /16 just 'because'
- All really bad stuff I saw so far was not with pASNs
- Those damn pASNs with their 1492 MTU...



2. Do not help but hinder IPv6 Deployment

Claim

- pASNs make IPv6
 deployment worse, because
 it keeps operators from
 rolling out IPv6
- They should just use HE tunnels

- The 1000-ish personal ASNs that there are wouldn't even make a v6 business case if they all were in *one* ISP
- (If you want to reduce the RT size, just drop v4; Plop, ~1M routes saved)




